The Minister authorized, the following municipalities to enforce sections 10 (3) (b), 11 and 24 of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act 54 of 1972), within their area of jurisdiction and through duty authorised officers:

Nkangala District Municipality
Lejweleputswa District Municipality
King Cetshwayo District Municipality
