"Food package" includes, but is not limited to, a food or beverage product that is contained in a food package or to which a food package is applied, a packaging component of a food package and plastic disposable gloves used in commercial or institutional food service) when sold individually or in bulk and not used in marketing, handling, or protecting a product).

- 6. **Description of content:** Proposed rule The Department is proposing a new rule: Chapter 90: Products Containing Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances. The rule provides additional guidance on the notification requirements and sales prohibitions for products and product components containing intentionally added PFAS pursuant to <u>38</u> <u>M.R.S. 1614</u>.
